Folden was diagnosed with acute myeloid leukemia in May 2003. Folden passed in September of 2004 at 2 years old. During their 15-month-long battle with leukemia, Folden's family experienced both the stress of caring for a child with a life-threatening illness and the overwhelming burden of the exorbitant medical costs associated with his treatment.

In 2004, Folden's friends and family founded the Me Fine Foundation as a way to pool resources for families facing life-threatening childhood illnesses. Me Fine helps families whose children are experiencing a medical crisis. Support comes in the form of both financial and emotional assistance.

"I am grateful to Me Fine for giving me an outlet and a purpose," she wrote. "I am so proud of what the organization has been able to do over two decades for families with sick children. It has far exceeded any expectation I ever had. As Me Fine outgrew me and took flight, I floundered for many years to find meaning for my existence."

Gale Healthcare Foundation assists in the national shortage of healthcare professionals. This organization offers scholarships to nursing professionals to further their education and training.

"Luckily, I stumbled upon the Gale Healthcare Foundation," Lori continued. "We do what we can to lift up the nursing community through educational scholarships and hardship assistance. I am grateful to Tony Braswell for his vision and his willingness to allow me to be a part of it all. I feel like I am somehow repaying those nurses who kept me afloat for all those months during Folden's illness and through my own battles with breast cancer. I don't know that any of this

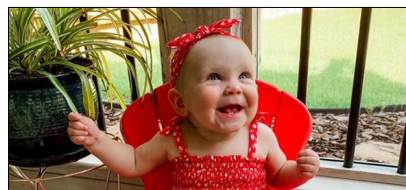

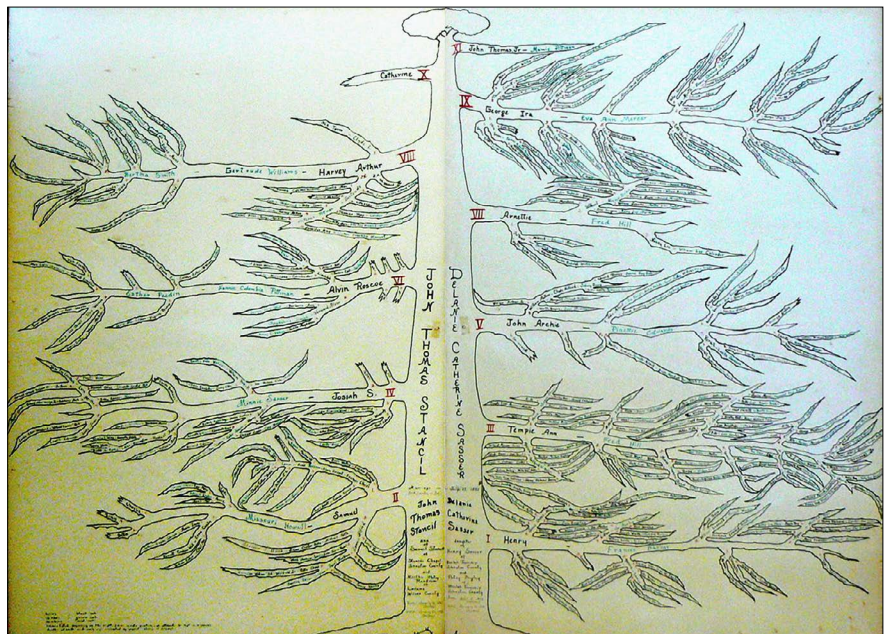

Highlights of annual J. T. Stancil Reunion

The John Thomas and Delanie Sasser Stancil family reunion dinner was enjoyed by the largest number ever attending – over 160 – at Glendale Community Club House on Aug. 26, 1973, the fourth Sunday official date set several years ago.

The original date was changed from Friday to Sunday because so many had left the farm to work elsewhere.

The blessing was given by J.

Millard Stancil, son of John Archer Stancil.

Not attending were those family members living in Hawaii, California and the Midwest and New York. There were relatives from Florida, Tennessee, Virginia, Washington, D.C., and Maryland.

The oldest one attending was Walter Greene Stancil, over 85, the oldest son of Henry Stancil and first grandchild of J.T. and Delanie.

The youngest attending was Vann F. Stancil, infant son of Donnell and Lou Stancil. Vann is the great-great grandson of the original pair.

The oldest lady present was Vann's grandmother Esther Peedin Stancil, widow of Alvin R. Stancil, also older

than 80.

One of the highlights of the occasion was the family tree drawn and displayed by Gilda Renfrow Six. The age-old pine tree in the yard of G.I. Stancil Jr. — the original homestead — was the pattern. The trunk represented John Thomas and Delanie while the limbs represented their children and descendants.

Gilda has four generations on the tree.

Durwood and Fernie Stancil displayed the Stancil Coat of Arms. Different spellings of the surname Stancil have occurred. Stancil is believed to be the original; however, Stancel, Stansell and Stancill have appeared in history.
